IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- Please book online before your child's first day.
- Packed lunch, snacks and drinks are required. **Please note: all Kidz Zone Clubs are nut-free zones**.
- Any children booked to stay past 4pm will receive a snack (sandwich or wrap / fruit or veg / biscuit).
- Please label all clothing and items being brought to the club.
- Please wear suitable clothing and trainers for indoor and outdoor activities: sun hats & sun cream during warmer days, or warm clothing & a waterproof when the weather is cooler or more seasonal.
- We suggest packing spare clothes.
- Sessions that are not attended are still charged unless 10 days notice is given.
- Sports activities will be outside as much as possible as per government guidelines so please wear warm clothing.

Covid-19 Safety Measures: Aiming to keep everyone SAFE!

Staff

- Completed 'prevent Covid-19' training and infection control training.
- To have the option of wearing face masks when inside.
- Wash their hands regularly as per government guidelines.
- Access to lateral flow testing.



Parents

- Do not enter the building under any circumstances.
- Please wear face masks when dropping off / collecting (unless medically exempt).
- Sign in and collect at a designated outside point.



Children

- **'Safety Bubbles'** we have restricted the number of spaces each day! Meaning children that attend will not mix with anyone outside of the recommended group size of 15 per group.
- Children's temperature is taken in the morning on our contactless temperature radar; before allowing access to the club; **any children with a temperature of 38C+ will not be allowed to attend.**
- Hand washing - on arrival, before and during activities, before and after eating, on departure.
- Social distancing - when indoors for snack and lunch we will set up the tables in the indoor areas for each group to meet social distancing requirements.
- **'Free Play' different zones for children to try.** Including football targets, tennis nets / swing ball, hoops & skipping, crazy catch & more!
- Infection control - we regularly clean anyway but will be doing more of this with disinfectant at regular periods throughout the day.
- Cleaning equipment - children will have their own ball for activities require a ball; that will be cleaned before and after use. Any other equipment used for activities will be cleaned before and after use with anti bacterial spray.
- **Outdoor activities - we will look to spend the majority of the day outside in dry weather!**



Activities

- Pre-planned and structured as part of our Covid-19 RISK assessment.
- Social distancing to be encouraged where possible.
- Staff will aim to encourage and educate children on social distancing during activities as best they can.
- Physical contact games kept to a minimum.
- Personal space pods marked out for certain activities.
